

## General information

Usage of radio stations is strictly regulated by the state authority. The Czech Telecommunication Office (CTO) is the authority in the Czech Republic. Radio stations can be operated only under conditions stated in the radio licence. There are two types of the radio frequency licences:

## General Authorizations

Some radios can work under conditions stated in general authorization (GA). Usage of the radios covered by GA is free of charge. For team communication are suitable GA:

All conditions stated by the GA must be respected! If you have any doubts, contact the CTO for consultation.

## Individual licence

You have to ask for individual temporary (short term) radio licence if you want to use stations, that do not fulfill requirements of the GA. Follow the process:

- Fill in the form and send it to the CTO (e.g. e-mail, fax, letter).
- Pay fee for the licence 3000 CZK (payment instructions will be sent by the CTO).
- Keep your radio licence (will be required during competition).

If you have any question, contact the Czech Telecommunication Office (accepted languages Czech and English).

**Important! All teams must present their radios and radio licences for approval. Tuned frequencies and their conformity with licence will be checked. The check will be done by state authority - CTO.**
